Executive Summary

Building the Global Infrastructure for Women's Leadership in the AI Era of Law and Harnessing AI for Justice

Context

AI is catalyzing tectonic shifts in law. How legal work gets done, how people access justice, and what it means to be a legal professional are being rewritten. Moments of deep disruption in law create an opening. AI transformation has cracked open the traditional legal system and created a rare window for paradigm change and power shifts. The question is no longer whether law will be transformed, but who will lead it and what they will build.

Core Challenge

Women worldwide face inequality and barriers in law. As professionals, they are excluded from leadership, encounter bias, and navigate inflexible environments. As people seeking justice, their legal needs go unmet. Digital transformation and AI threaten to amplify these inequalities and are already bringing new harms. Without intentional action, the AI era of law will concentrate power further and leave the four billion women who stand to benefit underserved.

Our Theory of Change

Lady Justice Initiative (LJI) exists to build global infrastructure for two linked missions: elevating women's leadership in law and AI governance, and harnessing AI for access to justice, especially for women and girls. Traditional leadership pipelines, finance ecosystems, networks, and governance bodies were not built for this moment. LJI is building the infrastructure that is.

If LJI equips women to lead in the AI era of law with AI competency, leadership capacity, entrepreneurship support, access to capital, and curated global networks; expands women's participation in AI governance and standards-setting; and supports practitioners harnessing AI for access to justice, especially for women and girls; **then** women will lead the AI era of law, justice will be native to what gets built, and the new era will advance opportunity and equality, **because** who leads shapes what is built, and what is built shapes who gets justice.

AI governance and standards-setting. Women's participation in the bodies writing the rules for AI in law.
